

**Warden Hill** may only be a small hill, but its summit (complete with iron age hillfort) sits above the confluence of the North and South Tyne rivers, allowing big views up both valleys. Commencing from Tyne Green Country car park, Hexham NE46 3HJ, the suggested 9-mile **BLACK** route (with 643ft of ascent) follows the River Tyne Trail to the confluence, crosses the South Tyne river to Bridge End, then heads uphill to the Iron Age Hill Fort via High Warden. The return route is made via Bridge End and Hexham Abbey. Alternatively, a short extension from the hill fort takes in the village of Fourstones. Refreshments are available en route at the Boatside Pub at Warden or in Hexham town centre.
