Housesteads & Sewingshields Crags - Housesteads Roman fort, is one of the best-known features of Hadrian's northern defence and is managed jointly by English Heritage and the National Trust. It sits on the lip of an impressive line of cliffs, overlooking a wild, undulating moss that extends to the north. Commencing from Housesteads car park, NE47 6NN, the 9-mile YELLOW walk (with 1073ft of ascent) arcs across this untamed landscape, climbing back for an exhilarating finale beside the wall.
