

## Hadrian's Wall from Once Brewed Sunday Walk

Hadrian's Wall is at its most impressive across the Pennines, its formidability heightened by the line of crags upon which it sits. Beginning from Once Brewed Visitor Centre, NE47 7AN the 7-mile (with 900ft of ascent) **BLACK** route climbs to the Stanegate, a military road servicing the frontier defence. The route then loops west to Cawfield Crags and follows the wall for some three miles, passing its highest elevation on Winshields Crags.
