Club Organised Transport -

- Car-Sharing (vehicle driver travels free of charge and receives fuel/parking expenses). It was unanimously AGREED to reintroduce this arrangement for Saturday walks in order to increase, when necessary, the number of seats on Club Organised Transport.
- Graeme reported that he was currently unable to commit to driving the Council provided minibus in respect of all 11 Saturday walks in 2022. Wackies had quoted £330 for a 15-seat minibus (with driver included) for a 210-mile journey to Seatoller. Jay's Taxi had quoted £320-£360 for a 16-seat minibus (with driver included) for a 210-mile journey to Seatoller. It was unanimously to reintroduce use of a minibus as Club Organised Transport in respect of Saturday walks and to subsidise the cost of empty seats out of Club funds where necessary.
